# Notice of Public Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a two-day public hearing on the application by SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc. for the renewal of its Nuclear Substance Processing Facility Operating Licence. SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc. has applied for a 3-year licence.

The SRB Technologies (Canada) Inc. facility manufactures sealed light sources containing tritium for use in luminous signs and other luminous objects. The facility is located in Pembroke, Ontario.

In accordance with the *Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission Rules of Procedure*, requests to intervene must include a written submission and, where applicable, the complete text of any oral presentation to be made to the Commission.
