The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing to consider an application by Ontario Power Generation Inc. (OPG) to authorize an amendment to the operating licence for the Darlington nuclear generating station (NGS), located in Darlington, Ontario.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing in this case is not necessary to consider OPG's application for amendments to the Darlington NGS operating licence. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions.
