## Notice of Hearing

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) will hold a hearing to consider an application by New Brunswick Power Nuclear Corporation (NB Power Nuclear) to authorize amendments to the operating licence for the Point Lepreau nuclear generating station. The station is located on the Lepreau Peninsula in New Brunswick.

The proposed amendments are being sought to reference updated versions of several Station Reference Documents. NB Power Nuclear has also requested an increase in the quantity limit of a sealed source used in prescribed equipment.

The Commission has determined that a public hearing is not necessary to consider NB Power Nuclear's application in this case. The hearing will be conducted by way of written submissions.

Following the deliberations and decision of the Commission on this matter, a *Record of* Proceedings, including Reasons for Decision will be published on the CNSC Web site and made available to the public.
