

### **Kinder Farm Camp**

For ages 4 and 5 (half days)

### **Fun at the Farm Camp**

For ages 6 to 8

Kids will discover what makes farming fun. They'll learn what it means to care for animals as they "adopt" a cow for the week. Nature studies, crafts, games, and more will fill your child's days with fresh air and fun.

### **City Farm Camp**

For ages 9 to 11

Who doesn't love cute and furry rabbits? City Farm Campers have the chance to get hands on experience with our camp rabbits as they brush, feed and clean them. But that's not all! They feed the sheep, tend their own garden, and grind wheat for bread. On the lighter side, campers make ice cream and play water games.

For ages 12 to 14
