- · change of clothes

The museum will provide a maximum of 150 floor mats. Please note that there are no showers available.

A WORRY-FREE EVENING

- · All our staff is trained in first aid and CPR
- All Museum exits are protected by alarms connected to the security room.
- There is a security guard on the premises 24 hours a day, and he/she can contact your group leader by radio at any time.
- The area set up for the night is located near the washrooms and an emergency exit. Before bedtime, our guide will explain the procedures to be followed should it be necessary to evacuate the premises.
- For all emergencies during sleepover hours, please call 613- 991-3100.

ACCOMPANYING ADULTS

- A minimum of 1 accompanying adult for every 5 children is required. During the program, accompanying adults may be asked to assist the guide with certain tasks.
- During the program, an adult must accompany a child who leaves the group for any reason (to visit the washroom, for first aid treatment, etc.).
- Accompanying adults must sleep in the same area as the children.

WAKE-UP AND DEPARTURE

- Wake-up time is 7 a.m.
- The program ends at 8:15 a.m. The children may wait in the lobby at the main entrance until their parents come for them.
- One accompanying adult must stay until the last child has left

PAYMENT

- The Museum requires a non-refundable deposit of \$100
 to guarantee the reservation. This can be done by telephone
 using Visa or Mastercard. Cheques made payable to the
 Canada Science and Technology Museum are also
 accepted.
- The balance of the account must be paid upon arrival.
 Only cheques are accepted on the day of the program.
