CATSA's website will provide you with information for packing your carry-on and checked baggage, what to expect at the pre-board screening checkpoint, special needs and things you can do before you get to the airport.

Here are a few helpful tips:

- Most pointed and sharp objects are not permitted beyond the pre-board screening checkpoint.
- Toy guns and gun replicas are not allowed beyond the checkpoint. Remember that a gun which may be a plastic toy can look like a real gun on an x-ray machine.
- Medication should be properly labelled and placed in your carry-on baggage.
- Before you leave home, be aware of the latest restrictions for carry-on baggage.
- Avoid the rush and arrive early!
