How to Apply for Financial Assistance

You may apply for financial assistance by filling out the paper form provided in this Guide or available through the financial assistance office of your educational institution. You can also fill out the e-form available on the Web site of Aide financière aux études (AFE) at <www.afe.gouv.qc.ca/english>. Nearly 90% of our clients use our on-line services. It's a fast, easy and secure way of applying for financial assistance.

If you are renewing your application for financial assistance, you may use the personalized form located on AFE's Web site, under *On-Line Access to Your File!* In order to facilitate the application procedure, AFE has already filled out part of the form using the information in your file on January 30, 2006.

How to Proceed Once Your Form Is Sent

The financial assistance to which you may be entitled will be assessed upon receipt of your form and required documents. A *Financial Assistance Statement* will be generated, informing you of the total amount of financial assistance (loan and bursary, if any) to which you are entitled. It will also give the breakdown of the installments you will receive (i.e. monthly or periodic installments). If you have provided an e-mail address, AFE will send you a message informing you of where to find your *Financial Assistance Statement* on the Web site. If you did not provide an e-mail address, you will receive your statement by mail.

If you are filing your first application for financial assistance, you must pick up your *Guarantee Certificate* from the financial assistance office at your educational institution. This document will be given to you at the beginning of your first study period. You should submit your certificate to your financial institution as soon as possible so that the financial assistance awarded to you may be deposited directly into your bank account.

If you are renewing your application for financial assistance, you will not be required to pick up a new *Guarantee Certificate*, since certificates are issued only once, at the beginning of your studies. Once the amount of assistance to which you are entitled has been assessed, the installments will be deposited directly into your account. If, however, you interrupt your studies for a period exceeding six months, you will require a new certificate, which you can obtain from the financial assistance office of your educational institution.

In addition, you must fill out a *Confirmation of Financial Resources* form in September and January in order to update or confirm the income you reported in your application for financial assistance. If you fail to do so, payment of your assistance will be suspended. The *Confirmation of Financial Resources* form is available on AFE's Web site, under *On-Line Access to Your File!*

What You Need to Know Before You Begin

Eligibility requirements

You qualify for the Loans and Bursaries Program if:

- you are a Canadian citizen, or a permanent resident, refugee or protected person within the meaning of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act*
- you are a Québec resident or are deemed a Québec resident at the time of your application
- you have been admitted to a recognized educational institution and:
 - you are pursuing full-time studies in a recognized program
 - or
 - you are deemed to be pursuing full-time studies in a recognized program
- you have not exceeded the maximum number of months of study for which financial assistance may be granted
- you have not reached the debt limit established for your level of education, type of degree or program
- you do not have sufficient financial resources to pursue your studies

Note: People who are serving a prison sentence are not eligible for the Loans and Bursaries Program.

How to proceed

To find out if you qualify for financial assistance and the amount to which you may be entitled, you must proceed as follows:

1. Fill out all sections of the *2006-2007 Application for Financial Assistance* and of *Schedule A—Student's Dependent Children*, if applicable. For help in doing so, consult pages 6 to 16 of the Guide.
2. Make sure you provide all of the required documents indicated by the circled numbers on the forms. These numbers refer to specific documents listed on pages 17 to 23 of the Guide.
3. Have your father, mother, sponsor or spouse fill out the appropriate declaration form(s). Pages 24 to 26 of the Guide have been designed for your parents or sponsor. Pages 27 to 28 concern your spouse.
4. Gather all of the documents you need to send:
 - signed forms
 - Schedule A, if applicable
 - supporting documents (Note: Your permanent code must appear on each document.)

Important: You have up to 60 days following the end of your last month of recognized studies of the award year in question to submit your application for financial assistance. Please note that forms may not be faxed.

Certain requirements could enable you to qualify for the Loans and Bursaries Program even though you are studying part-time. To find out if you may be deemed a full-time student, consult page 9 of the Guide.

Financial assistance awards

Amount to which you are entitled

Once your application for financial assistance has been processed, AFE will send you a *Financial Assistance Statement*. The statement will tell you, among other things, the amount of financial assistance to which you are entitled and the breakdown of your installments. If, when completing your application for financial assistance, you indicated that you wish to receive your correspondence by e-mail, you will receive an e-mail asking you to check your *Financial Assistance Statement* on AFE's Web site at <www.afe.gouv.qc.ca/english>, under *On-Line Access to Your File!*

Payment of your financial assistance

Is this your first application for financial assistance?

In the days preceding your first period of full-time studies, you must go to the financial assistance office at your educational institution. The personnel there will provide you with an envelope containing your *Guarantee Certificate*, among other things. In order for the financial assistance to which you are entitled to be deposited directly into your bank account, you must then submit all of the documents contained in your envelope to your financial institution.

Have you filed an application for financial assistance before?

If this is the case, you do not have any steps to follow to obtain the financial assistance to which you are entitled. Your assistance will be deposited directly into your bank account on the dates indicated in your *Financial Assistance Statement*.

Changes occurring during the year

Your financial resources

In September and January, you must confirm or update the income you reported in your application for financial assistance by filling out a Confirmation of Financial Resources form. You must fill out this form even if you have no changes to report with regard to your income. If you fail to do so, payment of the financial assistance to which you are entitled will be suspended. Please note that the amount of assistance awarded to you for the entire year will be reassessed at the end of the school year on the basis of the verification of information with Revenu Québec.

Your circumstances

You must inform AFE of any change that occurs during the year with respect to the information you provided in your application for financial assistance. To report a change in your circumstances, you will need to fill out a *Declaration of Change* form available at your financial assistance office or on AFE's Web site. You can also fill out the on-line version of the form on our web site—it's fast and easy!

Section 1: Student's Personal Information

A. Identification

Last name and first name at birth as given on your birth certificate

If this is your first application for financial assistance and you are a Canadian citizen by birth, you must:

Provide a copy of your birth certificate. It must give the last and first names of both your father and mother. If you were born in Québec, a copy of the full-sized birth certificate issued by the Registrar of Civil Status is preferable, since it contains all the required information.

Copies of birth certificates issued before January 1, 1994, by an authority other than the Registrar of Civil Status have legal standing and will also be accepted.

If you are not Canadian by birth, you must:

Provide the documents required in your situation, as listed on pages 17 and 18 of the Guide.

Permanent code assigned by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport

Example of a permanent code: TREP11596701

Your permanent code appears on your secondary school or college transcript and on all correspondence sent by AFE. You must write it on all documents that you send to AFE. If you fail to do so or if you provide an incorrect code, your application will not be processed.

If you don't have a permanent code:

AFE can have one assigned to you. To do so, AFE must have your place of birth (city and country) and the last and first names of both your parents (even if they are deceased). Only original documents or copies certified as true before a commissioner of oaths will be accepted if:

- you are a Canadian citizen by birth
- you are a naturalized Canadian citizen
- you are a permanent resident
- you are a refugee or protected person

The supporting documents you need to provide are indicated in the list of required documents.

Social insurance number (SIN)

If you don't have a SIN:

Apply for one at your local Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC) centre.

Important: It takes 6 to 8 weeks to process applications for a SIN, but you can still send us your application for financial assistance in the meantime. All you need to do is to send us your SIN as soon as you receive it.

Important

Some educational institutions assign each student a number they call a "permanent code" or "student number." This code or number should not be confused with the permanent code assigned by the Ministère de l'Éducation, du Loisir et du Sport.

C. Mailing address

Full address (including your postal code) and telephone number

Remember to enter your postal code and telephone number.

If your address or circumstances change during the year, you must notify AFE immediately to avoid delays in the payment of your financial assistance.

E-mail address

You may choose to receive your correspondence via e-mail exclusively. To do so, just enter your e-mail address in the space provided for this purpose on the application form. It's a fast and easy way to check the status of your file! Instead of receiving an AFE notice in the mail, you will receive an e-mail message asking you to check the status of your file on our Web site.

If you choose this option, it is important that you notify AFE of any change in your e-mail address.



Section 2: Residence in Québec

A. Criteria for Québec resident status

AFE may still consider you a Québec resident even if you answered NO to the first three questions of this subsection, which correspond to criteria 1, 2 and 3 in the following table. If you meet one of criteria 4 to 10 in the following table, you must enter the number corresponding to this criterion under question 4. If you entered 10, remember to indicate the criterion that applies to your spouse.



Criteria for Québec resident status

1. You were born in Québec.
2. One of your parents or your sponsor resides in Québec.
3. You hold a *Certificat de sélection du Québec* (Québec selection certificate).
4. Both your parents (or your sponsor) are deceased and one of them resided in Québec at the time of his or her death.
5. You still have your residence in Québec, although your parents (or your sponsor) now live elsewhere.
6. Québec is the last place where you resided for 12 consecutive months without pursuing full-time studies.
7. You were adopted by a person who resided in Québec at the time of your adoption.
8. You have been residing in Québec for at least three months and have not resided in another Canadian province for more than three months.
9. You have been in one of the following situations for three consecutive years within the last five years: 2, 5, 6 or 8.
10. One of the previously listed criteria (1 to 9) applies to your spouse.

B. Studying outside Québec

You must complete subsection B if you are or were pursuing studies outside Québec.

If you are or were pursuing studies outside Québec, and you are or were living in Québec at that time and your situation corresponds to one of the criteria in the preceding table “Criteria for Québec residence status”, you must enter criterion 11 (see table below) on the form.

If you are or were pursuing studies outside Québec, and you are or were **not** living in Québec at that time and, prior to leaving, your situation corresponded to one of the criteria in the preceding table “Criteria for Québec residence status”, you must enter one of the following criteria on the form: 12, 13, 14 or 15.

Studying outside Québec

11. You are studying outside Québec, you live in Québec and you are in one of the ten situations described in the preceding table. You are also able on a daily basis to travel between your home and your educational institution.
12. Your parents (or your sponsor) reside in Québec.
13. Your parents (or your sponsor) no longer reside in Québec, but left the province less than five years ago and resided in Québec before their departure.
14. You have not interrupted your full-time studies for more than 12 consecutive months since the date of your departure.
15. Your spouse has not worked outside Québec for more than 12 consecutive months since the date of your departure.

Note: Prior to leaving to study outside Québec, remember to sign a power of attorney that will enable a member of your family or a friend to have your *Guarantee Certificate* authenticated by your financial institution.



Section 3: Educational Information

Are you having trouble determining which subsection you need to fill out?

Consult the personnel of the financial assistance office at your educational institution or of AFE.

Which subsection should you fill out?

The section relating to educational information is divided into subsections A and B.

You must fill out **subsection A** if:

- you are enrolled in a regular college or university program (Note: This is the case if, for example, your school year is divided into three terms—called study periods in the Guide and the forms—starting and ending at fixed dates.)
- you are enrolled in a Télé-Université or Cégep@distance program (i.e. distance education programs)

You must fill out **subsection B** if:

- you are enrolled in a college-level continuing education program leading to an Attestation of College Studies (ACS)
- you are enrolled in an intensive or accelerated program leading to a Diploma of College Studies (DCS)
- you are enrolled in a secondary school vocational training program leading to a Diploma of Vocational Studies (DVS) or an Attestation of Vocational Specialization (AVS)

General Information Regarding Subsections A and B

Reduction of the student contribution with regard to part-time studies

You may be entitled to a contribution reduction if you are or were pursuing part-time studies during the 4-month period preceding the start of your full-time studies in 2006-2007.

Keep the following in mind:

- If you are or were pursuing part-time studies in more than one educational institution or program, you must attach a separate sheet of paper to your form with the name of the educational institution and its code and the number of course hours (college) or credits (university) for which you are or were enrolled.
- If you are pursuing part-time studies, you may qualify for the Loans and Bursaries Program if you are deemed to be pursuing full-time studies. To find out if this is your case, read the following text which deals with full-time studies and studies deemed full-time.

Full-time studies and studies deemed full-time

To qualify for the Loans and Bursaries Program, you must be a full-time student or be deemed a full-time student. To find out if this is your case, you must meet at least one of the following requirements:

You are a full-time student if:

- The educational institution you are attending in Québec considers you as such. If you have any questions regarding this matter, consult the personnel of the financial assistance office at your educational institution.
- The educational institution you are attending outside Québec considers you as such. To find out which documents you need to provide if this is your case, contact AFE or consult the section “Studies Outside Québec” on AFE’s Web site.

You are deemed a full-time student if:

You are studying part-time, i.e. you are not studying full-time, are **enrolled for at least 20 course hours per month and meet one of the following four criteria:**

- You are a single parent and you are living with your child who is under age 12 as of September 30, 2006.
or
you are living with your child who is under age 21 as of September 30, 2006, and your child is a student with a major functional disability or mental disorder.
- You have a spouse* and you are living with a child (either yours or your spouse’s) who is under age 6 as of September 30, 2006.
or
you are living with your child who is under age 21 as of September 30, 2006, and your child is a student with a major functional disability or mental disorder.
- You are at least 20 weeks pregnant.
- You have a major functional disability.

Name and code of educational institution and program

The names and codes of educational institutions and programs are listed on pages 29 to 41 of the Guide.



* If you and your spouse are students, only one of you can be deemed to be a full-time student during the award year in question.

Year of the program

If you are enrolled in one of the following programs, please specify which year of the program you reached or will reach in 2006-2007. If in doubt, contact the financial assistance office at your educational institution.

Important

If you are doing or did a compulsory practicum during a study period and you cannot or could not live at your place of residence during this period, you must indicate that you are or were pursuing full-time studies instead of a full-time practicum. You must then send AFE a duly completed *Student Practicums* form. AFE will recognize your practicum expenses.

Full-time practicum

AFE defines a practicum as a period of practical training in the workplace. You must indicate that you are or were doing a full-time practicum if:

- The practicum extends over a period of time corresponding to a study period (e.g. the fall of 2006, the winter of 2007, the summer of 2007) and is declared a “full-time practicum” by your educational institution. Practicums usually last between 12 and 16 weeks.
- The practicum is compulsory and provides credits.
or
If you are pursuing **college studies**, the practicum is part of a work-study program (WSP).
If you are pursuing **university studies**, the practicum is part of a cooperative program.

If you are or were enrolled in a **regular program** and your practicum meets none of the previously listed requirements, check the “Full-time studies” box.

You may do a practicum during your **secondary (vocational training) studies** or your **college (continuing education) studies**. If the practicum extends over the above-mentioned period of time **and** is compulsory and provides credits, make sure you include it when you enter the duration of your program.

For more information, consult the personnel of the financial assistance office at your educational institution.

Details Concerning Subsection A “College or university studies (regular program)”

University education—Master’s degree

Program with or without thesis/dissertation

A thesis or dissertation is a comprehensive written paper on a given problem. Its author must demonstrate that he or she can make a contribution to a specific field of study.

If you have to or had to write a thesis/dissertation at the end of your master’s degree program, check one of the boxes under “Program **with** thesis/dissertation.”

If, on the other hand, you had to submit essays or complete directed studies, check one of the boxes under “Program **without** thesis/dissertation.”

University education—Master’s and Doctoral degree

Writing of thesis/dissertation

Check the “Submission of thesis/dissertation” box if you meet or met the following requirements:

- You have completed the writing of your thesis or dissertation during the previous study period.

- You will be submitting your thesis or dissertation during the study period in question. This is the only step left for you to complete your program.
- You have to enroll for the study period in question in order to be able to submit your thesis or dissertation and you will be considered a full-time student by your educational institution.
- You will have to pay tuition fees or administrative fees to enroll.

Details Concerning Subsection B “Secondary (vocational training) or college (continuing education) studies”

Start date and end date of your program

Enter the start date and end date of your program. Make sure you specify the year in which your program started and that in which it will end.

If you **change educational institutions or programs** in 2006-2007, you will need to have the *Notice of Change of Educational Institution or of Program* form filled out by the person in charge of financial assistance at your educational institution.

If your program **begins two months or less** prior to the start of an award year and **ends two months or less** after the end of this award year, please read the following:

- If your program **starts before July 1, 2006**, you must fill out one application for financial assistance for **2006-2007** and another one for **2005-2006** to ensure that your financial needs for the summer of 2006 (i.e. from May 1 to August 31, 2006) are taken into account.
- If your program **starts after June 30, 2006**, you must fill out **only one application for financial assistance for 2006-2007**. Your financial needs for the summer of 2006 (i.e. from May 1 to August 31, 2006) will be taken into account.
- If your program **ends before November 1, 2007**, you must fill out **only one application for financial assistance for 2006-2007**. Your financial needs for the fall of 2007 (i.e. from September 1 to December 31, 2007) will be taken into account.
- If your program **ends after October 31, 2007**, you must fill one application for financial assistance for **2006-2007** and another one for **2007-2008** to ensure that your financial needs for the fall of 2007 (i.e. from September 1 to December 31, 2007) are taken into account.



Section 4: Student’s Situation

The information you provide in this section will enable us to determine which of the following student categories you fall into:

- student with a parental or sponsor contribution
- student without a parental or sponsor contribution
- student with a spousal contribution

AFE considers you a “self-supporting” student if you fall into one of the last two categories.

A. Marital status

De facto spouse

You may be considered a de facto spouse in accordance with one or more statutes (see box). The answers you provide in this subsection and elsewhere in the form will enable us to determine if you are a de facto spouse according to AFE’s criteria.

If you are living as though married with a person without being married or in a civil union, and if you were **never married or in a civil union**, you must indicate that you are single.

While the *Civil Code of Québec* does not grant de facto spouses legal standing, certain Québec statutes (e.g. the *Taxation Act* and the *Act respecting financial assistance for education expenses*) do recognize de facto spouses. However the criteria for recognition of de facto unions vary from one Act to another.

If you are living as though married with a person without being married or in a civil union, but have previously been **married or in a civil union** with another person from whom you are now separated, you must indicate that you are either divorced, legally separated or de facto separated, as the case may be. If the person to whom you were married or with whom you were in a civil union is deceased, you must indicate that you are widowed.

Civil union spouse

The civil union is a commitment by two persons who consent to live together. The civil union is contracted openly before a competent celebrant, as is marriage, and is witnessed through a civil union act.

Legally or de facto separated

De facto separated persons are still married or in a civil union, but they are separated from their spouses, without having obtained a court judgment granting them legal separation. As for **legally separated** persons, they were once married or in a civil union but have since obtained a court judgment granting them legal separation.

Do you need special equipment, special services or paratransit in order to be able to pursue your studies? If so, you may qualify for the Allowance for Special Needs Program.

B. Major functional disability

A major functional disability is defined as a permanent functional handicap that limits the ability to study. It must be recognized by a doctor. If you have such a handicap, you qualify for special measures under the Loans and Bursaries Program. The following disabilities are recognized: severe hearing impairment, severe visual impairment, motor impairment and organic impairment. The last two disabilities are recognized when they result in significant and persistent limitations. The disabilities recognized are defined in the *Medical Certificate—Major Functional Disabilities and Other Recognized Disabilities* form, which must be completed by your doctor and attached to your application for financial assistance.

C. Self-supporting student (based on family situation)

Biological or adoptive parent of a child

A biological parent is a person who has a child of his or her own (whether the child is alive or deceased). An adoptive parent is a person who has legally adopted a child (whether the child is alive or deceased).

Single parent

A single parent is a person who does not have a spouse and who has custody of at least one dependent child (his or her own) living with him or her. A person cannot be a single parent if he or she is not a biological or adoptive parent.

De facto spouse

AFE defines a de facto spouse as a person who is living as though married with a partner (of the opposite sex or the same sex) without being married or in a civil union and who is living with at least one child (either his or her own or his or her spouse's).

AFE will recognize your transportation costs if there is no overland transportation between your home and your educational institution or the organization hosting your practicum, provided they are both located in Québec. You must send us the *Declaration of Change—Student* form duly completed.

D. Self-supporting student (based on studies)

Bachelor's degree earned outside Québec

If you obtained a bachelor's degree outside Québec, you must provide the appropriate supporting document (see situation 21 on the list of Required Documents on page 21). If you obtained your diploma outside Canada, you must provide a copy of the comparative evaluation for studies done outside Québec, issued by the Ministère de l'Immigration et des Communautés culturelles.

As regards studies pursued in Ontario, only the following diplomas are accepted:

- honours bachelor's degree earned in Ontario
- bachelor's degree with a specialization earned in Ontario

Equivalent of 90 credits earned toward a single university degree outside Québec

Check the appropriate box if you meet one of the following requirements:

- you have been studying at the university level outside Québec for at least four years
- you hold a Diploma of College Studies (DCS) and have been studying at the university level outside Québec for at least three years toward a single university degree

Important: A year is counted for each school year during which you pursued full-time studies at the university level, whether for one, two or three study periods (fall, winter, summer).

E. Self-supporting student (based on time spent in the labour market)

Independent for 24 months

To be recognized as a self-supporting student on the basis of the time you spent in the labour market, you must have supported yourself for 24 months (consecutive or not) **without ever studying full-time during this period**. You may have been in one of the following situations:

Situation 1

While living with your parents, sponsor or elsewhere:

- you held a paid job
or
- you received employment insurance benefits (including maternity and sickness benefits)
or
- you received income replacement benefits from the Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (CSST), the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) or another organization

Example

You had a paid job for nine months, received employment insurance benefits for six months and then held another paid job for six months. Subsequently, you received income replacement benefits from the CSST for three months. At no time during this entire period were you a full-time student.

Situation 2

In certain circumstances, you may be recognized as a self-supporting student if you supported yourself in a different way than those mentioned previously, all the while living elsewhere than with your parents. For more information, consult the personnel of the financial assistance office at your educational institution.

Example

You received employment assistance (income security) benefits during 24 months while living elsewhere than with your parents. In such a situation, you will be required to provide a copy of your lease(s), covering this 24-month period.

Are you recognized by AFE as having a major functional disability and have you been pursuing university studies in or outside Québec? You need to have earned 45 credits (instead of 90 credits) to be recognized as self-sufficient with regard to your studies. You must therefore send us a duly-completed declaration of change form and your most recent transcript.



Income replacement benefits are amounts paid by the following organizations, in connection with a job you have held:

- Régie des rentes du Québec
- Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec
- Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (benefits paid for an occupational injury or an occupational illness or to a crime victim)
- Human Resources and Skills Development Canada
- Social Development Canada (benefits from the Canada Pension Plan)
- Ministère de l'Immigration et des Communautés culturelles (benefits paid for acts of good citizenship)

F. Self-supporting student (based on an exceptional family situation)

You may be recognized as a self-supporting student on the basis of your exceptional family situation if none of the statements in subsections C, D and E apply to you, and if your situation with respect to your parents, sponsor or spouse is exceptional. If this is the case, you must submit the *Declaration of Exceptional Family Situation* form duly completed by an authorized person along with your application for financial assistance.

Parents or sponsor living in a special care home

Check the box corresponding to this situation only if both your father **and** your mother are living in a special care home. If this is the case, you must provide a duly completed *2006-2007 Declaration of Father* form and a duly completed *2006-2007 Declaration of Mother* form. If only one of your parents is living in a special care home, you must fill out subsection G instead.

Parents or sponsor cannot be located

Check the box corresponding to this situation only if both your father **and** your mother cannot be located. If only one of them cannot be located, you must fill out subsection G instead.

Living in a halfway house in 2006-2007

People who are serving a prison sentence are not eligible for the Loans and Bursaries Program. Only those who are living or who will be living in a halfway house in 2006-2007 can file an application for financial assistance.

Deteriorated family situation

Check the box corresponding to this situation if your family situation has deteriorated so much that you had to leave home. If this is the case, you must provide either or both of the *2006-2007 Declaration of Father* or the *2006-2007 Declaration of Mother* forms.

If you had to cease communication with one of your parents because of a serious problem (such as alcoholism, incest, violence or a disagreement), you must provide the form of the parent with whom you still communicate (i.e. the *2006-2007 Declaration of Father* form or the *2006-2007 Declaration of Mother* form).

If in doubt as to which form(s) you need to provide, please consult the personnel of the financial assistance office at your educational institution.

G. Student with a parental contribution

If you need to fill out this subsection, make sure that your father or your mother, or both (i.e. depending on your situation) send AFE their duly completed declaration form.

Important

The financial assistance to which you may be entitled will not be assessed until AFE has received the requested declaration form(s).

Permanent resident, naturalized Canadian citizen or refugee

If both your parents reside outside Canada at the beginning of the award year, you must have the *2006-2007 Declaration of Father* form or the *2006-2007 Declaration of Mother* form filled out by your sponsor. If you do not have a sponsor, check the appropriate box in subsection F.

Section 5: Other Financial Support Programs

Emploi-Québec manpower training measure

You are not eligible for the Loans and Bursaries Program if you are participating in a manpower training measure offered by Emploi-Québec and if you are attending an educational institution under the authority of a school board or a public college-level institution.

You may, however, qualify for financial assistance under the Loans and Bursaries Program if you are in one of the following situations:

- you are enrolled in a given program offered at a private secondary school or college
- you are enrolled in a given program offered at a university
- you are enrolled in a given self-financed program offered at a college

Please note that your educational expenses will be the only expenses recognized. Moreover, if your educational expenses are paid in full by Emploi-Québec, you will not be awarded any financial assistance.



Section 6: Financial Resources

A. Employment income and income considered employment income

You must report the income you have received or expect to receive between January 1 and December 31, 2006.

If you cannot provide the exact amount, give as accurate an estimate as possible. On several occasions during the school year, you will have the opportunity to confirm or change the income you reported.

Income related to an election

You must report the income you earned as:

- an election official
or
- a candidate representative (only if you were assigned to this position by proxy)

This includes income earned on the advanced polling day, on the polling day and for the necessary training to perform the duties on these occasions.

Employment insurance benefits

Employment insurance benefits are paid by Human Resources and Skills Development Canada (HRSDC). Until 1997, these benefits were known as “unemployment insurance benefits.”

Important: At the end of the school year, the income you report is systematically checked against the information on file at Revenu Québec. Under paragraph (o) of section 69.1 of the *Act respecting the Ministère du Revenu*, AFE does not need the person’s consent in order to run such checks.

If you fail to report an amount, you risk having to repay all or part of the financial assistance you received. The installments expected for the current award year or a subsequent year may serve to reimburse the amount owed.



B. Other income

Orphan's pension, pension for a disabled person's child, surviving spouse's pension, death benefits in the form of pensions and pensions paid to the child of a crime victim

Indicate only the amount that you have received or will receive starting at age 18 since, with few exceptions, the amount awarded to you prior to age 18 is generally paid directly to the person who has responsibility for you. You are therefore not required to report it.

Support payments

You must enter the total amount that you have received or that you will receive for yourself or for a child in the form of support payments. You must report the actual amount received or to be received, taxable or not, even if it is not the same as the amount indicated in the court judgment. Do not report support payments received by either of your parents to provide for your needs.

Scholarships or bursaries

You must enter the total amount of any scholarships or bursaries you have received or will receive in 2006.

You must exclude bursaries received under the Loans and Bursaries Program. Please note that the **portion**, if any, financed by the Canada Millennium Scholarship Foundation is also excluded. **Other scholarships or bursaries** awarded by the Foundation, however, are not excluded.

You must also report bursaries awarded by AFE to elected executive officers of provincial student associations.

Do not report:

- Bursaries from the Explore program
- amounts paid by the Régie des rentes du Québec (RRQ) as part of its child assistance measure (provincial family allowances)
- Canada child tax benefits
- social assistance benefits (income security)
- Canadian university bursaries from a registered education savings plan (e.g. Universitas)
- amounts paid by the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec (SAAQ) or the Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail (CSST) as compensation, for example, for the loss of a limb or to reimburse certain expenses (physiotherapy, orthopedic devices, etc.)
- withdrawals from a pension plan (RRSP, RRSF, RREGOP, etc.)
- benefits from a strike fund
- income from rental units
- lottery winnings

C. Employment in the summer of 2006

If you were employed or self-employed by more than one employer while living elsewhere than with your parents, indicate the name of one of your employers only and your workplace address.



Section 7: Signature

Your application for financial assistance will be processed **only if it is signed**. If you do not sign your application form, it will be returned to you by mail and the processing of your file will be delayed.

Important: Each year, AFE audits files. You should be prepared to back up all the information you provide in the application form, Schedule A and supporting or other documents.

The amount of financial assistance awarded to you may be claimed if you make any false statements. Furthermore, if you fail to comply with an audit request within the specified time, your financial assistance for the current year may be cancelled and further assistance denied.

List of Required Documents (Student)

Do you have to provide a sworn declaration?

The following persons are authorized to administer oaths, i.e. take a sworn declaration: lawyers, notaries, justices of the peace, mayors, municipal clerks and commissioners of oaths.

Some educational institutions and financial institutions appoint members of their staff to act as commissioners of oaths.

You must submit originals of the application for financial assistance, Schedule A and the various AFE forms that you are asked to fill out. Copies will be accepted in all other cases. Please note that you do not have to resubmit documents supplied with a previous application if the information contained in these documents is still up-to-date.

All forms mentioned under “Required Documents” are produced by AFE. They are available from the student financial assistance office at your educational institution and on our Web site at <www.afe.gouv.qc.ca/english>.

Please take the time to read the third column below, “Important Information.” It provides details on the required documents mentioned in the middle column.

Important: Documents that do not meet the requirements stated below will not be accepted. If you need help, contact the financial assistance office at your educational institution.
