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Phase One – e-Transfers (implemented)

Phase Two – e-Postings (implemented)

Some users are unsure of the next steps to take when they receive a status of **Expired Agreement** in the updated report they receive after a posting request is submitted.

- If the status of the parcel reads **Expired Agreement** on the updated response, this means that you have requested rights in a location with an active agreement that is past the expiry date. Your request for the rights still held by that agreement will be withdrawn. You will need to resubmit your request again once the agreement is either continued or cancelled.
- To help you keep track of the agreement until a decision is made by the department, you need to enter the agreement number into the **Expired Agreement** page in the Posting Request folder when you are logged in on your ETS account. Phase Three – e-Bidding

- Acceptance testing for the e-Bidding application began on November 28, 2005 and is proceeding on schedule.
- Members of the e-Bidding working group participated in two business functionality testing sessions on January 19, 2006. The goal of the participants was to see if the system met their business needs and to supply feedback about the performance and operation of the application.
- The P&NG Tenure Information Exchange is scheduled for **Friday, April 28, 2006** at the Telus Convention Centre.
- An overview of the e-Bidding application will be one of the highlights of the day. This will be your chance to learn more about the project and have your questions answered.
- The only way to bid on P&NG and oil sands parcels for the **June 28, 2006** sale will be by using the e-Bidding application.
- Hands-on training will take place in May and June 2006.
