

## Phase One – e-Transfers (implemented)

- Very few paper copies of transfers were received after January 1, 2005.
- Turnaround time for transfers is now about one week.
- Should a party involved in a transfer refuse to concur, a new feature has been added to allow a Creator to cancel a transfer in concurrence.

## Phase Two — e-Postings

- There are only **21** days remaining until the launch of e-Postings on March 30, 2005.
- Sign up now for access to e-Postings (or amend your current ETS account) by filling out and faxing in the *Electronic Transfer System (ETS) Account Set Up Form* found at: <u>www.energy.gov.ab.ca</u>.
- Client accounts and their associated roles for e-Posting may be set up starting March 14, 2005.
- The **only** way to post lands beginning <u>March 30, 2005</u> will be by using the e-Postings system.

## Phase Three — e-Bidding

- Development for e-Bidding is now in the works.
- e-Bidding will be mandatory when launched (anticipated date of June 2006)
