Phase One -e-Transfers (implemented)

• The creator will now get an email advising that your transfer is completed by the Department.

Phase Two – e-Postings (implemented)

- Upon saving your posting request, the system creates an "Original" file which will detail the lands and rights being requested. This file will indicate the submission date and time, once you have submitted your request. This file will not change once it has a submission date.
- Remember to read your "Update" files to determine what has changed from your original request. The update file can be modified as the Department processes your request.
- "Original" and "Update" files can be accessed through the "Work in Progress" screen.

- e-Bidding will be mandatory when launched with the first electronic sale expected for June 28, 2006 (exactly one year from the publish date of this issue).
- A business system design document is currently under review.
- An information session will be held in April 2006 on e-Bidding and hands-on training will take place in May and June of 2006.
