Phase One – e-Transfers (implemented)

- With a few exceptions, manual transfers will no longer be accepted for Petroleum and Natural Gas and Oil Sands Agreements after **December 31, 2004**.
- Get access to the system and use it today to make it easier on you when it becomes mandatory.
- To sign up for access to e-Transfers, fill out and fax in the *Electronic Transfer System (ETS) Account Set Up Form* found at: <http://www.energy.gov.ab.ca>

Phase Two – e-Postings

- The e-Postings system began internal acceptance testing October 18, 2004. Members of the working committee will assess screens for ease of use and business functionality on November 23 and 24, 2004.
- Please register for the **e-Posting Information Exchange** to be held Thursday, November 25, 2004 at the Metropolitan Centre.
- This forum will allow you to learn more about e-postings and give you an opportunity to ask questions. This is a joint initiative of the government, the Canadian Association of Petroleum Landmen (CAPL) and the Canadian Association of Petroleum Land Administration (CAPLA).
- Registration for the Information Exchange is on-line via CAPLA's website www.caplacanada.org.
- Topics that will be covered at the November 25, 2004 session include: An overview of the e-postings project, examples of the roles and how to set them up, implementation timeline, policy and process changes, training, how and when you can sign up.

Phase Three – e-Bidding

- e-Bidding will be mandatory and development is scheduled to begin in April 2005, with a “go live” date of **March 2006**.
