Phase One – e-Transfers (implemented)

- Oil sands and petroleum and natural gas (P&NG) paper transfers received after **December 31, 2004** are being returned unregistered, with a few exceptions.
- Coal and mineral transfers are acceptable in either paper or electronic format.
- To sign up for access to e-Transfers, fill out and fax in the *Electronic Transfer System (ETS) Account Set Up Form* found at <http://www.energy.gov.ab.ca>.

Phase Two – e-Postings

- Only 62 days to the launch of e-Postings.
- Training will take place as follows:
 - Overview training - February 3 and 4 at the EnCana Amphitheatre.
 - Hands-on training - February 22-24, March 1-3, and March 15-17 if necessary, at Monenco Place.

Phase Three – e-Bidding

- e-Bidding will be mandatory.
- The e-Bidding working group is scheduled to begin planning and development in April 2005, with a “go live” date of March 2006.
