Services Nouveau-Brunswick

Businesses can now register online for both Service New Brunswick (SNB) and Canada Customs and Revenue Agency business programs. Business response to this enhancement has been favourable. It simplifies the registration process when starting up or expanding a business.

SNB has enhanced the level of services available to businesses through ongoing modernization of the Corporate Affairs Registration Database. Businesses can incorporate online and e-file annual returns and notices of change of directors. Any business that has registered for a business number (BN) can conduct an Internet search of its own record free of charge by using its unique New Brunswick Business Account Number. More than 48,500 New Brunswick BNs have been assigned.
