## INFORMATION

In anticipation of upcoming vacancies, the New Brunswick Advisory Council on Youth is now accepting applications or nominations for appointment to the Council.

<u>Please note</u> that the Lieutenant Governor in Council will make all appointments and only appointees will be contacted to confirm their appointment.

The New Brunswick Advisory Council on Youth (NBACY) is the provincial body representative of youth, which voices the interests, needs, concerns and perspectives of young people aged 15 - 24 in New Brunswick, and presents recommendations to government and the public.

The NBACY consists of 13 members from all across New Brunswick. The Council was established as a body for study and consultation, and reports to the Premier of New Brunswick.

### Council Membership

The Lieutenant Governor in Council appoints all NBACY members for a term of 2 years, subject to re-nomination. Appointees must be available to attend quarterly Council meetings (four times per year). Transportation and lodging are pre-paid and per diem is provided for food and other expenses under Provincial travel guidelines.

#### Roles of Council Members

Attend regular meetings of the full Council (held four times per year)

Keep themselves and the Council aware and informed of appropriate information on youth-oriented issues, events, activities and organizations.

Act as a contact person for the Council

Provide input to other members and the Council office when the Council prepares reports on youth issues and concerns

Share information about and promote Council activities

Provide written or oral reports at each full Council meeting
