- 2. A plan including sufficient time in which to cover the curriculum
- 3. An area dedicated to learning during the time formal instruction is provided
- 4. Adequate support materials. This may include:
 - a. Encyclopaedia

- f. Dictionary/thesaurus, reference materials
- c. Educational software
- g. Calculator
- d. Educational games
- h. Age-appropriate reading materials
- 5. Effective testing. This may include:
 - a. Standardized tests (e.g. Canadian Test of Basic Skills)
 - b. Provincial exams (please contact your school district if you would like your child to participate in provincial exams)
