

ELIGIBILITY FOR FRENCH ORAL PROFICIENCY EVALUATION

FOR GRADE 12 STUDENTS

Students in grade 12 who are enrolled in a French language course, either Core French or Immersion, or who are enrolled in a subject course taught in French, are eligible for an oral proficiency evaluation.

Provincial evaluators visit schools during each semester. Students are scheduled for an evaluation during the semester in which they take their last grade 12 French course. If students who are not yet in their final year of high school are enrolled in a grade 12 French course, they would also be eligible for a proficiency evaluation, since their French program would be deemed complete. However, an individual student may be evaluated only once. Therefore, should a student in this situation subsequently choose to take a subject course in French, he or she would not be reevaluated.

Following each round of evaluations, the Department of Education issues a Certificate of Proficiency in the name of each individual student attesting to the level he or she achieved on the New Brunswick Oral Proficiency Scale.
