SUGGESTED TOPICS FOR INCLUSION IN THE SCHOOL POSITIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT PLAN

The School Positive Learning Environment Plan may:

- define expected behaviour standards for in-school, co- and extra-curricular activities and conduct on school buses;
- state expectations and responsibilities for staff, pupils, parents and volunteers and include a process to follow should any partner have a complaint;
- specify steps to be taken when a serious incident occurs;
- identify strategies for recognizing good behaviour, successes and accomplishments and for monitoring progress;
- promote activities which develop: self-esteem, communication, social skills, respect for self and others, self-control, productive behaviour, peaceful and cooperative problem solving, conflict resolution and the practice of democratic principles;
- ensure differences in age groups, abilities, learning styles, needs and strengths are recognized;
- promote age-appropriate pupil participation in decisions affecting them, as a group or individually, and encourage team-work with staff and peers;
- include equitable, common-sense, consistent consequences for pupil misconduct. Consistency should be evident to pupils from situation to situation and staff member to staff member;
- ensure a fair process for finding out what happened when things go wrong and for finding a remedy;
- include a reporting plan to ensure parents, volunteers, bus drivers and other staff involved with a pupil are informed of significant events such as: interventions in school or on buses, injuries/illness, absences, achievements, etc., as appropriate;
- identify training needs for staff, parents and pupils and contain a plan for obtaining the necessary training;
- address coordination of services received by pupils;
- include a communications plan to ensure the School Positive Learning Environment Plan is understood by pupils, parents, volunteers, staff and the community and is communicated annually to all involved in the school; and
- contain steps for monitoring and furthering successes achieved in creating a positive learning environment.
