

## COPYRIGHT

### Why is copyright permission needed?

Copyright laws protect the original producer, writer, and/or publisher of material from the unauthorized reproduction of that material. You must keep in mind that the unauthorized reproduction of material from scientific reports is no different than that of music, novels, and videotapes, and is subject to prosecution. It is imperative that permission be obtained from the copyright holder to reproduce any previously published figure, photograph, or other text material — **and this is your responsibility.**

A [Copyright permission form](#) has been prepared to help authors with this task. It is available from the [Forms](#) section on our website.

Almost all journals and publishing organizations hold copyright on articles that they publish. **Even if you created the figure for publication in a journal article and you wish to use it again in a GSC publication, you must ask the journal for permission to use it, as the journal holds copyright.** Check the colophon page of the journal to see if written permission must be obtained to reproduce a figure or photograph. For example, the *Canadian Journal of Earth Sciences* grants blanket permission to reproduce figures, etc., as long as the source is acknowledged. Any figure or photograph originally published in a GSC publication does not require permission to be used in another GSC publication. Permission is not needed to reproduce figures, etc. published by other federal government departments.

### When is copyright permission not needed?

If the figure has been **substantially** altered, then copyright permission is not needed, and the source should be acknowledged in the figure caption like this: (*modified from* Smith, 1998, Fig. 3). If you are uncertain if the changes are substantial enough, please enclose photocopies of the original figure and your modified version, and the Editorial Unit will make that decision. **Please note that simply redrafting and/or changing the patterns on a figure does not constitute substantial change.**
