



PIKOGAN

DESCRIPTION

The Pikogan Reserve consists of lots 25 (part), 26 (part) and 27 (part) of Range 2 of the township of Dalquier.

Total area: 88.6 hectares.

LOCATION

The Pikogan Reserve is located 3 kilometres from Amos, on the west shore of the Harricana river.

LAND TITLE HISTORY

March 13, 1956 - REGISTRATION NUMBER X17150

The Government of Canada purchases from Lucien Leclerc lots 26 and 27 (part) of Range 2 of the township of Dalquier. Area: 52.36 hectares (129.39 acres).

October 10, 1958 - REGISTRATION NUMBER 16937

Government of Canada Order in Council 1958-1387 - Setting apart of the lots purchased in 1956 for the use and benefit of the Amos Indians.

August 7, 1968 - REGISTRATION NUMBER 3792

Order in Council 1968-1549, passed in compliance with the *Indian Act* (R.S.C. 1952, chapter 149, section 35) - The Government of Canada transfers to the Québec Government the control and administration of a portion of lots 26 and 27 of Range 2, township of Dalquier, for road widening purposes. The area indicated is 0.42 hectare (1.06 acre).

June 2, 1979

The Government of Canada purchases from Mrs. Gabrielle Brunelle-Pard, householder, a portion of lot 25 of Range 2, township of Dalquier. Area: 38.60 hectares (95.38 acres).

December 13, 1979 - REGISTRATION NUMBER 67528

Government of Canada Order in Council 1979-3385 - Setting aside of the lot purchased in 1979 for the use and benefit of Amos Indians.

CHRONOLOGY OF BOUNDARY SURVEYS

- 1) **1959**: survey of lot 26 and lot 27 (part) of Range 2, township of Dalquier, by J.-Aimé Fleury;
- 2) **1976**: survey of lot 63 of Range 2, township of Dalquier, in replacement of a portion of lots 26 and 27 of the same range and township;
- 3) **1979**: survey of lot 25-1 of Range 2, township of Dalquier, by Paul Descarreaux;
- 4) **1981**: resurvey of the boundaries of lot 26 (part) of Range 2, township of Dalquier, by Paul Descarreaux;
NOTE - The CLSR plan 68 100 and the RSQ plan 555 should be revised to indicate they concern the outer boundaries of lot 26 part, not of lot 26 as a whole;
- 5) **1994**: clearing of the reserve's outer boundaries, restoration and laying of wooden reference posts by members of the band.
