



SAINT-AUGUSTIN

DESCRIPTION

The Saint Augustin Settlement includes block A, parcel 1 of block 197, as well as blocks 201 and 202, according the original survey of the township of Verrazzano.

Area: approximately 3 hectares.

LOCATION

The settlement is located on the west bank of the Saint Augustin river, 550 kilometres north-east of Sept Îles.

LAND TITLE HISTORY

June 4, 1971

Letter of authority from the Québec Ministry of Lands and Forests authorizing the Government of Canada to build houses for the Indians of Saint Augustin.

July 27, 1987 - REGISTRATION NUMBER 114744

The Saint Augustin Band changes its name to "Pakua Shipi Montagnais Band".

CHRONOLOGY OF BOUNDARY SURVEYS

As this settlement is under provincial control, the lands required for the needs the Indians are surveyed in compliance with Québec's instructions, and made available to the federal government pursuant to the 1971 letter of authority. Negotiations are under way with Québec to create a new reserve in that area, as planned during the 1998-99 fiscal year.
