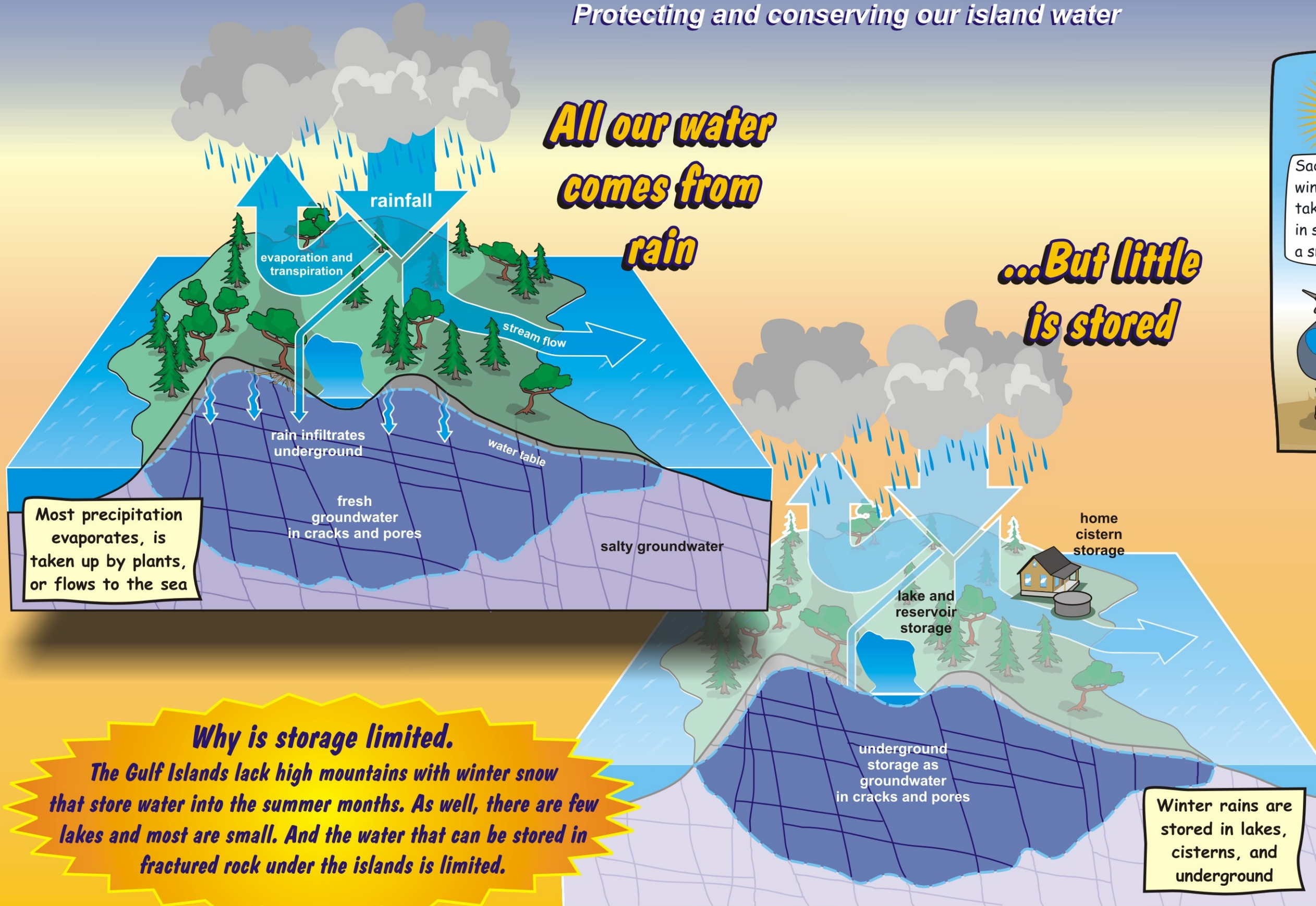


Protecting and conserving our island water



Why is storage limited.

The Gulf Islands lack high mountains with winter snow that store water into the summer months. As well, there are few lakes and most are small. And the water that can be stored in fractured rock under the islands is limited.
