


Protecting and conserving our island water

A good septic field is a maintained septic field. Make sure your septic field is inspected and pumped regularly.





How do islanders protect the quality of water supplies?

> There are many ways. And most protection is just common sense. For example, I check my septic tank annually to ensure it is functioning properly. Failed septic fields are a major source of drinking water contamination on the islands.
