NOTE: Right hand circuits when runway 06 in use. Take-off on 06 start right turn within 2 miles from end of runway. On authorized straight-in approaches to runway 24 maintain minimum of 1500' ASL until past Cartierville runway 28.

NOTE: High intensity bar lights (clear) at 300' intervals. Long bar light (clear) 1000' from runway. Centre bar 200' from runway and the two adjacent bars off centre line are red. Low intensity amber lights with every other bar light (200' intervals).

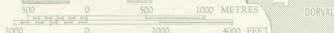
