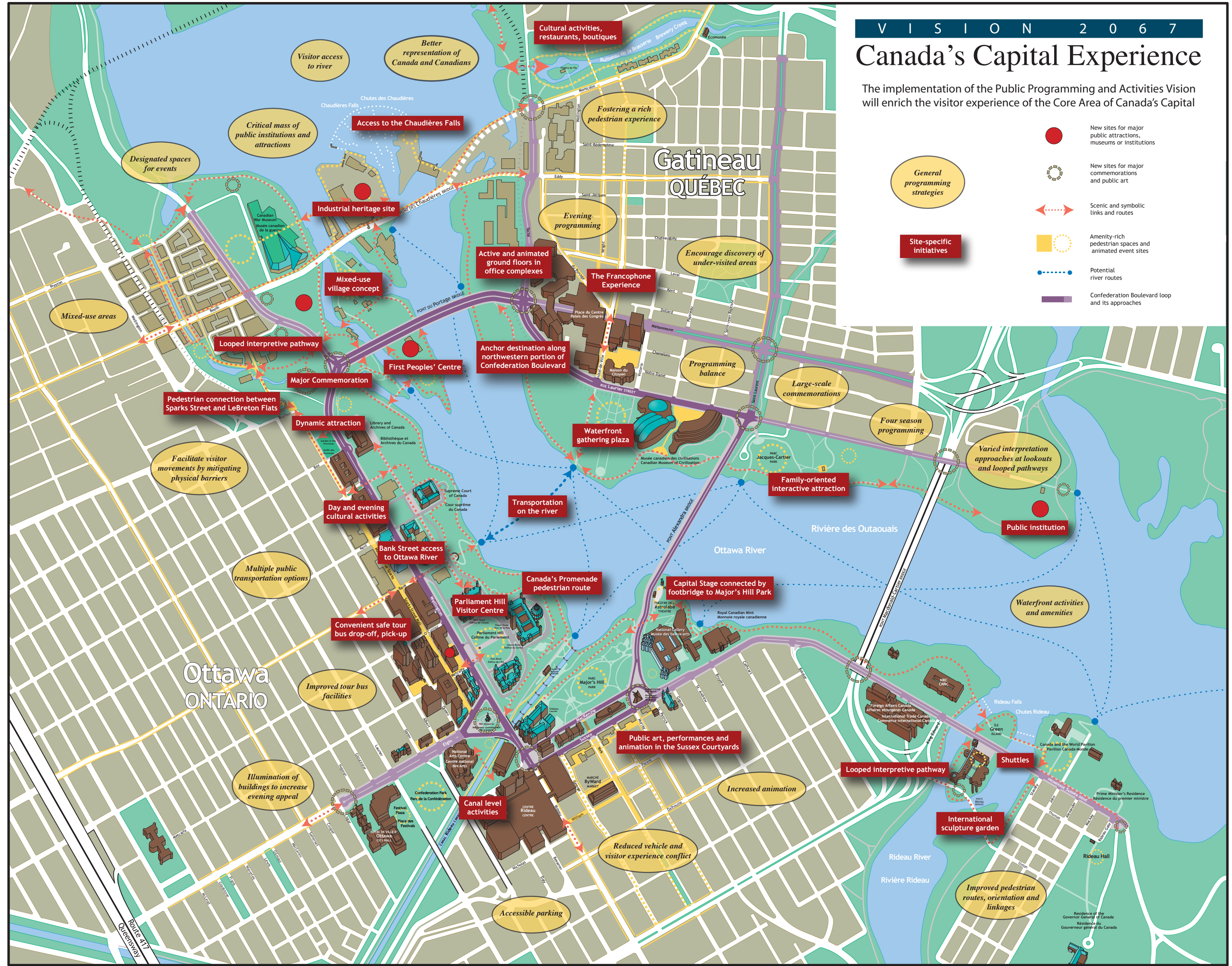


# Canada's Capital Experience
