You may also be asked to submit to fingerprinting. Please bring a piece of photo ID when you come to the Volunteer Centre for your interview. Please note that teenagers 16 and 17 years of age are also subject to this procedure.

Undertaking to act in a responsible and safe manner — I hereby undertake and agree to act in a responsible and safe manner at all times while acting as an NCC volunteer.

Insurance — The NCC maintains insurance to the benefit of its volunteers while they are acting as such. This insurance coverage is for claims arising out of injuries to third parties which are caused by the negligence of the volunteer and for accidental death or dismemberment of a volunteer that occurs in the course of NCC volunteer activities.
