Explosives Vendors:

It's your job to know your buyers

The Government of Canada is committed to keeping explosives out of the hands of criminals and terrorists. Everyone in the country who deals with, or in, explosives has a duty to assist the government in the effort to maintain national security.

Do your part as a vendor by making sure you satisfy these three basic obligations:

1. NEVER deliver or sell explosives to anyone you don't know.
2. NEVER deliver or sell explosives to people who can't, or won't, identify themselves.
3. NEVER sell or deliver explosives to anyone who does not have a valid magazine licence (unless you are ready to issue a Purchase and Possession Permit).
