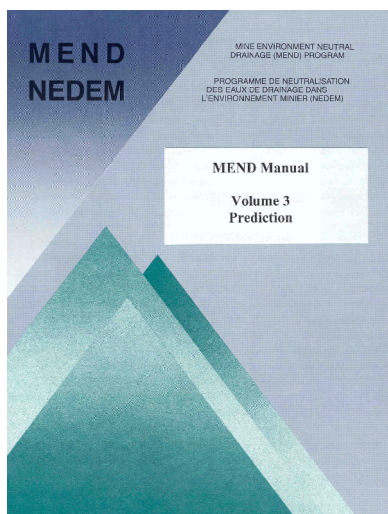


MEND Manual
