INFLUENZA ACTIVITY IN NEW BRUNSWICK

October 8, 2006 to October 14, 2006 (week 41)

1. Reports of influenza-like illness (ILI) from New Brunswick physicians for the National Flu-Watch Program (20 physicians recruited this year report number of patients with ILI symptoms over total number of patients seen on one day each week):

12 physicians reported 3 cases of ILI of the 261 patients seen for any reason during this reporting period

2. Report of New Brunswick Influenza Virus Surveillance Program (specimens are submitted by recruited sentinel physicians, Emergency Rooms, nursing homes and some community physicians). All specimens are tested by PCR, which is used as a rapid detection method. All PCR positive cases are considered probable and are confirmed by viral culture and/or different PCR test (Table 1). Confirmed influenza cases are reported for the week when the laboratory confirmation is received (Table 2):
