OSFI has received numerous communications about this company which appears to be soliciting funds under the pretext of issuing winning lottery advices. Please be advised that this matter is currently under investigation by Canadian law enforcement officials. If you have any information or are solicited by this organization, do not respond. ALERT RE: FORGED INTERNATIONAL LETTERS OF CREDIT

OSFI has received a warning from the Consul General of Ecuador in Montreal that US\$500 million in forged letters of credit are in circulation in the name of Banca Nacional de Fomento.
