



WHERE YOU CAN FIND MOSQUITO LARVAE ON YOUR PROPERTY?

Where to look	What can you do	✓
Bird baths	Clean and replace water weekly. Scrub inside of birdbath monthly.	
Rain collection containers	Cover tightly with window screen, seal at downspout or add 1 cup of bleach to a full barrel weekly.	
Unused containers	Store inside or turn upside down.	
Old tires	Store inside, take to recycling depot, or drill holes so water will drain.	
Ornamental ponds	Install circulating pump, add fish (goldfish, Fat Head minnows) or use Bti	
Kiddie pools	Change water weekly, cover or turn over when not in use.	
Pool and pool covers	Maintain water quality and remove water and/ or surface debris from covers.	
Boats	Use a boat cover, turn over or allow water to drain.	
Plant saucers	Remove water every couple of days.	
Eavestroughing	Keep clean and direct rainwater away from low lying areas.	
Low-lying areas	Fill in with soil and seed or re-sod.	
Pet dishes	Change water daily.	
Children's toys	Store inside when not in use or dump out water every couple of days.	
Flat roofs	Maintain roof drain and remove any debris.	
Water troughs	Change weekly or stock with fish.
