- Understand the links between Search and Reply, other ESS functions and the Central Registry and Inquiry Bureau
- Understand the role of each station of Search and Reply
- Participate in operating the Search and Reply function of Family Reunification

- Family Reunification: Front Line Operators (R&I)
- Reception Centre Operations (recommended)
