- Oversee the work of Front Line workers and Search and Reply workers to ensure reunification is achieved quickly and efficiently
- Assess the need for additional human resources, supplies etc.
- Arrange for the recruitment and training of new workers

- Family Reunification: Front Line Operators (R&I)
- Family Reunification: Search and Reply
- Reception Centre Operations
