

Incident Command System Intermediate Level I-300

Target Audience:

For those who are at a senior supervisory level within their organization and may be called upon to manage medium to large sized emergency incident sites or those who may have a supervisory role in these.

Course Description:

Duration: 3 Days

This course provides participants with knowledge and skills to manage a medium to large sized emergency site. Participants work through a variety of more progressive challenging incident scenarios.

Course Objectives:

On completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Apply concepts and procedures for medium and large size incidents
- Apply systematic assessment method
- Apply risk management principles
- Organize the structure of response to various sizes and types of incidents
- Assume command of a moderate sized incident
- Utilize ICS facilities as appropriate to an incident's needs
- Manage larger numbers and a variety of resources
- Set-up and/or manage in unified command
- Apply necessary and appropriate leadership, delegation of authority and supervision to or within elements of the response
- Provide multi-agency and multi-jurisdiction coordination
- Know parameters for effective communications for medium sized incidents
- Apply proper ICS colour identification

- Apply ICS standardized supervisory assignments and operational guidelines
- Organize and provide briefings

Topics include:

- Organizing and Staffing
- Organizing for Incidents or Events
- Incident and Event Planning
- Unified Command
- Incident Resources Management

Prerequisite:

- Incident Command System Orientation I-100
- Incident Command System Basic Level I-200

Type of Instruction:

Lecture, group activities, scenarios and exercises

Class Size:

12 Minimum, 24 Maximum
