Course Description:

NESS orientation presentation providing an overview of the management of the stockpile including types of units and supplies, inventory control, distribution warehousing, federal legislation, policy, standards and guidelines.

Course Objectives:

To train participants on the set up and operation of the Emergency Hospital within the municipalities.

Topics include:

- Overview and practical exercise of using Emergency Hospital Technical Guide, color codes and where to find the supplies and equipment in the Hospital
- Hands-on training of set up of functional areas of the Hospital
- Daily training assessments
- Open house and tours if required

Prerequisite:

Candidates, upon completion of the course must be prepared to carry on their own training program within the communities where the 200 Bed Emergency Hospitals are stored.
