The Basic Emergency Preparedness Course, or its equivalent, is now offered by the provincial/territorial Emergency Measures Organization (EMO). This is an entry level course and, along with its provincial/territorial equivalents, is considered a prerequisite for all other courses conducted at the College.

- Operating procedures and how they are applied to a spectrum of emergency scenarios.
- The management, command, control and co-ordination functions necessary to meet emergencies are examined using case studies and exercises.
