

Casualty Simulation Instructor Course

Course Sponsor:

Health Canada in consultation with Provincial/Territorial
Emergency Health Services Directors

Target Audience:

Individuals interested in learning the instructional techniques to teach the Health Canada Basic Casualty Simulation course at a provincial/territorial level; and the skills and knowledge necessary to coordinate the casualty simulation portion of emergency preparedness exercises.

Candidates should be chosen with the participant restrictions and the prerequisites in mind.

Participant Restrictions:

Casualty simulators/Instructors provide their services on a volunteer basis.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will be expected to take the lead in the coordination and delivery of the Health Canada Basic Casualty Simulation Course in their province/territory as well as provide coordination for the casualty simulation portion of exercises.

Course Description:

Duration: 4 days

This course consolidates participant's basic casualty simulation skills. It also focuses on instructional strategies and skills in teaching the basic course. It is intended for those interested in returning to their province/territory to deliver the basic course. A second objective of the course is to prepare participants to act as the coordinators for the casualty simulation portion of emergency preparedness simulation exercises.

Course Objectives:

On completion of this course, participants will be able to:

- Instruct and evaluate the creation of basic simulations of injuries using materials provided in the Health Canada Basic Casualty Simulation Kit
- Coordinate the casualty simulation portion of an emergency preparedness simulation exercise.

Each participant will be supplied with materials to update their Kit (on loan from Health Canada) with the materials necessary to provide casualty simulation for exercises.

Prerequisite:

Completion of the Health Canada Basic Casualty Simulation Course and 2 years of experience as a casualty simulator.

Type of Instruction:

Lecture, discussion and hands on practice. There will be an evaluative component included. In order to successfully complete course student must score a minimum of 70%.

15 Maximum. Instructor student ratio, 1:5
