

Emergency Operations Centre Course

Course Sponsor:

Manitoba Emergency Measures Organization (MEMO)

Target Audience:

This course is for the EOC manager and support staff within the EOC.

Participant Restrictions:

This includes municipal management, fire, police, ambulance/hospital, provincial departments, agencies and volunteer organizations.

Course Description:

Duration – 2 or 4 days

This course provides an orientation to the community roles and functions of an emergency operations centre (EOC).

Course Objectives:

Topics include:

- Designing an EOC
- EOC operations
- Staffing
- Information management
- Communications

Prerequisite:

Applicants *MUST* have successfully completed the Manitoba Emergency Management Course (MEM) or equivalent.

Type of Instruction:

Training consists of 2 days of theory and, in the 4-day format, an additional 2 days of practical exercises.

Class Size:

Due to the exercise-based format of this course, communities wishing to host must ensure a group of 20-22 participants from police, fire, ambulance, emergency coordinators, public works and emergency social services.
