

Basic Emergency Preparedness Online (web-based)

Course Sponsor:

New Brunswick Emergency Measures Organization in conjunction with other Atlantic EMOs

Course Description:

Duration: Self-Study & 1-Day session

This course is structured to provide the participant with a broad base from which to carry out planning and operations for emergencies. This course is an online version of our traditional Basic Emergency Preparedness. It is a self-paced course which combines CD-ROM, the Internet, and print to present the content. The CD-ROM and print materials contain the most part of the content, while the Internet is used as a communication tool for students and instructors and for the provision of student support materials. This is an entry level course and is considered a prerequisite for advanced level courses including those courses given at the Canadian Emergency Preparedness College.

Course Objectives:

Topics include:

- Theory of the planning process
- Operating procedures and how they are applied to a spectrum of emergency scenarios.
- The management, command, control and co-ordination functions necessary to meet emergencies are examined using case studies and exercises.

Prerequisite:

None - This is an introductory level course. Candidates do not require any previous training in emergency preparedness to attend this course.

Type of Instruction:

CD-ROM, Internet self-study with a one-day face-to-face workshop
