The course introduces the candidate to the principles of emergency operations and control. The candidate receives an introduction to the standard operating procedures applied in an EOC. The focus of the course will be on the organizing and exercising of an EOC. Successful candidates will receive an accredited certificate.

Prerequisite:

Candidates must have successfully completed the Emergency Plans and Operations (EPO) course or equivalent course.

Type of Instruction:

Lectures and tabletop exercises. Successful candidates will receive an accredited certificate.
