

## **Emergency Operations Centre Management**

**Course Description:**

This is an advanced level course designed for planners and officials to operate effectively as staff members of an Emergency Operations Centre (EOC).

**Course Objectives:**

Topics include:

- Basic principles of emergency operations and control
- Standard operating procedures for the EOC
- Practical aspects of organizing and managing Emergency Operation Centres

**Prerequisite:**

This is an advanced level course. Candidates must have successfully completed the Basic Emergency Preparedness course.

**Type of Instruction:**

Lectures and tabletop exercises.

**Course Location:**

The Emergency Operations Centre Management course will be held at the Federal-Provincial Joint Emergency Operations Centre (JEOC). The JEOC is located at the EMO (NS) Headquarters, 12 Mount Hope Avenue, Dartmouth.
