Revisions to Labour Force Survey

Every five years, Labour Force Survey (LFS) estimates undergo extensive revisions. At the beginning of 2005, revisions were made to estimates so that all numbers have been adjusted to reflect 2001 Census population counts. Until now, LFS estimates have been based on population counts from the 1996 Census. The LFS has an established history of conducting such “re-basing exercises” after each Census.

As a result of these changes, LFS estimates have been revised back to January 1992 for Yukon data. These changes **do not** involve modifications to the questionnaire or content of the survey.

Users must be aware that historical comparisons of estimates currently produced by the LFS must be made with revised historical data contained in this publication.

Population re-basing

The Labour Force Survey (LFS) uses estimates of the target population, derived independently from the survey, as benchmarks for producing survey estimates. These population estimates start with a Census base and are updated using administrative data, to reflect the federal estimate of Yukon’s population. Using these population estimates reduces the sampling error and coverage bias of survey estimates. Proper population numbers are crucial in determining estimates from a sample survey like the LFS. In order to translate the results of the sample into estimates, each individual in the sample is assigned a weight indicating the number of persons in the population that individual represents.

The Census base used for obtaining these estimates is updated several years after each new Census is conducted. Beginning with the release of the January 2005 survey, population estimates used by the Labour Force Survey changed from a 1996 Census base to a 2001 Census base.

Definitions:

1. Employment

Employed persons are those who, during the reference week, did any work for pay or profit, or had a job and were absent from work.

2. Employment rate

Also referred to as "employment/population ratio", it is the number of employed persons expressed as a percentage of the population aged 15 years and over. The employment rate for a particular group (for example, women aged 25 years and over) is the number employed in that group expressed as a percentage of the population for that group.

3. Goods-Producing Industries

Goods-Producing Industries (or goods sector, or goods industries): includes agriculture, other primary industries (forestry; fishing and trapping; mines, quarries and oil wells), manufacturing, construction and utilities (electric power, gas and water).

4. Labour force

The labour force is the civilian non-institutional population 15 years of age and over who, during the survey reference week, were employed or unemployed.

5. Not in the labour force

Persons not in the labour force are those who, during the reference week, were unwilling or unable to offer or supply labour services under conditions existing in their labour markets, that is, they were neither employed nor unemployed.

6. Participation rate

The participation rate is the total labour force expressed as a percentage of the population aged 15 years and over. The participation rate for a particular group (for example, women aged 25 years and over) is the labour force in that group expressed as a percentage of the population for that group.

7. Reference Week

The reference week is the entire calendar week (from Sunday to Saturday) covered by the Labour Force Survey each month. It is usually the week containing the 15th day of the month. The interviews are conducted during the following week, called the Survey Week, and the labour force status determined is that of the reference week.

8. Seasonal adjustment

Fluctuations in economic time series are caused by seasonal, cyclical and irregular movements. A seasonally

adjusted series is one from which seasonal movements have been eliminated. Seasonal movements are defined as those which are caused by regular annual events such as climate, holidays, vacation periods and cycles related to crops, production and retail sales associated with Christmas and Easter. It should be noted that the seasonally adjusted series contain irregular as well as longer-term cyclical fluctuations.

9. Self-employed

There are two broad categories of workers: those who work for others and those who work for themselves, namely, the self-employed. The self-employed includes working owners of incorporated businesses, working owners of unincorporated businesses and other self-employed.

10. Service-Producing Industries

Service-Producing Industries (or service sector, or service industries): includes trade; transportation and warehousing; finance, insurance, real estate and leasing; professional, scientific and technical services; management, administrative and other support; educational services; health care and social assistance; information, culture and recreation; accommodation and food services; other services; and public administration.

11. Three Month Moving Average

All Yukon monthly figures, whether seasonally adjusted or unadjusted, are three month moving averages - for example, the March 2004 unemployment rate of 6.0% is actually an average of the unemployment rates for the months of January, February and March. For April's unemployment rate the average will "move" one month over to being February, March and April.

12. Unemployment

Unemployed persons are those who, during the reference week, were available for work and were either on temporary layoff, had looked for work in the past four weeks or had a job to start within the next four weeks.

13. Unemployment rate

The unemployment rate is the number of unemployed persons expressed as a percentage of the labour force. The unemployment rate for a particular group (age, sex, marital status, etc.) is the number unemployed in that group expressed as a percentage of the labour force for that group.
