Visitation to the Yukon was down 8.1% or 6,556 visitors from last July (see table below). The only increase was noted in Motorcoach (up 5.7% or 1,377 visitors) traffic.

<u>Motorcoach</u> traffic saw an increase in U.S. (up 11.2% or 2,121 visitors) travelers, however Canadian (down 24.6% or 683 visitors), and Foreign (down 2.3% or 59 visitors) travelers showed decreasing figures over July 2005.

<u>Private vehicle</u> traffic saw negative figures in Foreign (down 25.8% or 1,174 visitors), Canadian (down 18.1% or 1,393 visitors), U.S. (down 13.5% or 5,322 visitors), and Yukon (down 2.3% or 144 visitors) travelers.

Year-To-Date

Year-to-date travel was down by 2.2% or 4,223 visitors (see table below). The only increase was noted in Motorcoach (up 15.7% or 9,101 visitors) traffic.

Port of Arrival

Length of Stay

Same Day Travel

"Same day" travel was up 9.2% or 3,126 travelers passing through. Motorcoach (up 20.4% or 3,594 visitors), U.S. (up 11.9% or 3,046 visitors), Foreign (up 9.0% or 197 visitors) and Yukon (up 3.3% or 96 visitors) travelers showed increases over July 2005.

Canadian (down 6.7% or 213 visitors), and Private Vehicle (down 2.9% or 468 visitors) traffic showed declining figures over July 2005.

One or More Night

"One or more night" visitation was down 20.3% or 9,782 travelers. Motorcoach (down 33.5% or 2,217 visitors), Foreign (down 29.2% or 1,430 visitors), Canadian (down 25.5% or 1,863 visitors), U.S. (down 19.1% or 6,247 visitors), Private Vehicles (down 18.2% or 7,565 visitors), and Yukon (down 7.1% or 242 visitors) travelers showed declining over July 2005.

Marine travel was up 14.0% or 292 visitors from July 2005 (see table below).
