

INSTALLING YUKON GEOSCIENCE PUBLICATIONS DATABASE

To install the Microsoft Access 2000 version of Yukon Geoscience Publications Database you require:

- PC with Pentium 75 MHZ or higher processor
- Microsoft Windows 95 or later operating system, or Microsoft Windows NT
- Workstation operating system version 4.0 with Service Pack 3 or later
- Recommend 32 MB of RAM
- Hard disk space required for a minimum installation: 150 MB.
- CD-ROM drive
- Mouse or compatible pointing device

This CD-ROM contains two different versions of the Yukon Geoscience Publications Database. The data in each database is the same, the only difference is in the software used to operate the database.

YG_DB_Access2000 – This folder contains an Access 2000 database file. It is to be used by users who already have Access2000 loaded on their computers.

YG_DB_Runtime_Version - This folder contains a runtime version of the Yukon Geoscience Publications Database in Access 2000. This version should be used by users who do not have any version of Microsoft Access loaded onto their computer.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

There are two ways to install the Yukon Geoscience Publications Database.

A) Computers which do not possess any version of Microsoft Access.

If the computer the user is using, to view this database, **does not** have any version of Microsoft Access loaded onto it, the user should use the following installation instructions.

- 1) Close all programs that may be open.
- 2) Insert Yukon Geoscience Publications Database CD-ROM into appropriate drive.
- 3) At the bottom left hand corner of the screen click on the Windows **Start** button.
- 4) Select the **Run** command from the Menu bar.
- 5) At the run line command, type: d\YG_DB_Runtime_Version\setup.exe (where d: is the name of your drive that you inserted the CD-ROM into).
- 6) The installation wizard will guide you through the install process. This will install a run-time version of Access 2000 onto your computer.

B) Computers which possess Microsoft Access version 2000 or higher

If the computer the user is using to view this database has Access 2000 or higher loaded onto it, the user should load the Access2000 database file (folder marked **YG_DB_Access2000**) onto their hard drive and run the database using the Access program loaded on their computer. Make sure you have set the read only flag on the attribute properties of the file to off prior to using the database. The user can still load the runtime version if they so wish but they may encounter problems loading the runtime version if they already have previously installed version of MS Access loaded on their computers.
