

# Census '96

## Age, Sex, Marital Status and Common-law Status

The following statistics are from the 1996 Census of Canada which occurred on May 14, 1996.

### 1

#### Highlights

- In 1996 the percentage of never married (single) people in the Yukon was 45.8%; in 1991 it was 45.8%; in 1986 it was 47.6%; and in 1971 it was 53.0%.
- In 1996 the percentage of married (including common-law) people in the Yukon was 44.9%; in 1991 it was 45.8%; in 1986 it was 44.1%; and in 1971 it was 41.4%.
- In 1996 the percentage of separated, divorced and widowed people in the Yukon was 9.4%; in 1991 it was 8.4%; in 1986 it was 8.3%; and in 1971 it was 5.6%.

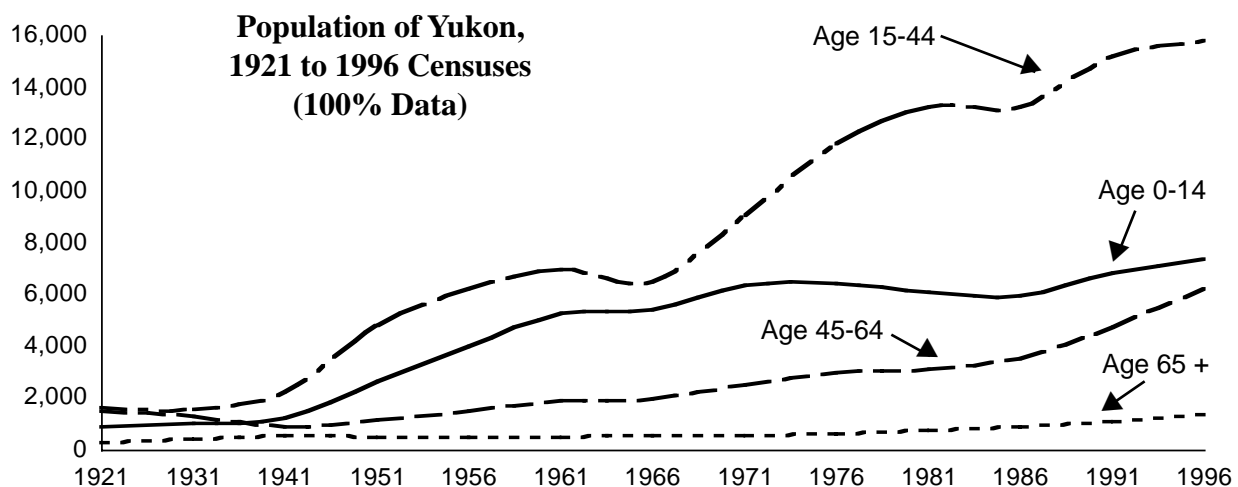

## 6 Common Law Status, Yukon, 1991 and 1996

In 1996, out of a total population of 23,380 people age 15 years and over, 3,705 (15.8%) were living in common-law unions in the Yukon. In 1991, this figure was 2,835 or 13.5% out of a total population age 15 years and over (20,955).
