Highlights

The following statistics are from the 2001 Census of Canada which occurred on **May 15, 2001.**



The percentage of people in the Yukon 15 years and over having a level of education less than a high school graduation certificate

declined from 27.5% in 1996 to 24.5% in 2001.

University Degrees

The proportion of people in the Yukon 15 years and over who have at least a Bachelor's degree has increased to 15.8% in 2001 from

Field of Study

14.5% in 1996.

The most common major field of study by people 15 years and over in the Yukon who have University degrees or certificates is educational, recreational and counselling services (22.4%); for those with Trades or other non-university certificates, applied science technologies and trades (39.7%).
