Highlights

The following statistics are from the 2001 Census of Canada which occurred on **May 15, 2001**.



Age

The 2001, the age group with the highest population (2,990) was ages 40 - 44 years. In 1996, the age group with the highest population was ages 35 - 39 years.

Sex

There were 14,440 males in the Yukon in 2001, as compared to 14,235 females.

Marital Status

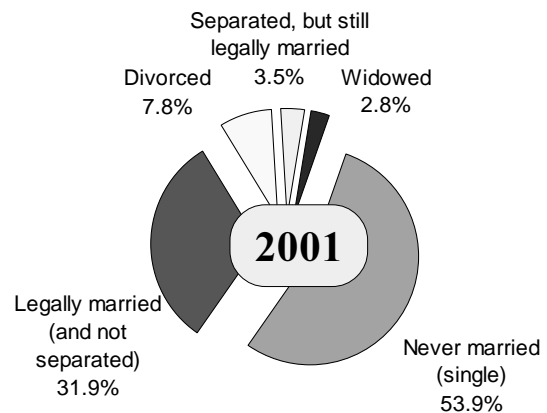
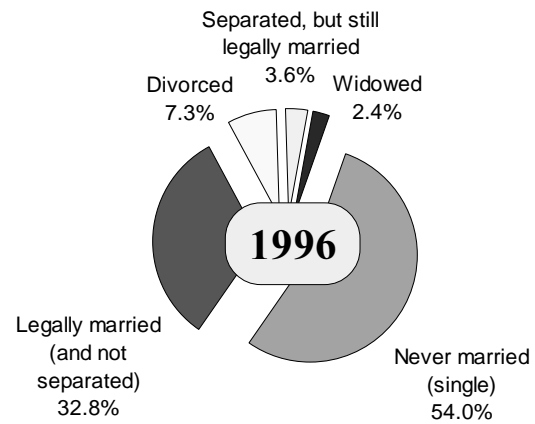
In 2001, married people represented 31.9% of the total population, down 0.9 percentage points from 1996, when married people represented 32.8% of the population.

Notes

Never married (single): Persons who have never married (including all person less than 15 years of age) and persons whose marriage has been annulled and who have not remarried.

Legally married (and not separated)*: Persons whose husband or wife is living, unless the couple is separated or a divorce has been obtained.

Separated, but still legally married: Persons currently married, but who are no longer living with their spouse (for any reason other than illness or work) and have not obtained a divorce.

Divorced: Persons who have obtained a legal divorce and who have not remarried.

Widowed: Persons who have lost their spouse through death and who have not remarried.

* In 2001 and 1996, Aboriginal people married according to traditional customs were instructed to report themselves as legally married.

Additional statistics from the 2001 Census are currently available, including population, dwelling counts, language, mobility, migration, citizenship, immigration, ethnic origin, aboriginal peoples, labour force activity, occupation, place of work, mode of transportation, unpaid work, school attendance, education, highest level of schooling and earnings. A release on May 13, 2003 will provide information on religion, shelter costs, income and social and economic characteristics of individuals, families and households.

Please Note: The majority of figures shown in this publication have been subjected to a confidentiality procedure known as “random rounding” in which counts are rounded to a multiple of “5”.
