Dwellings

Highlights

The following statistics are from the 2001 Census of Canada which occurred on **May 15, 2001.**



Of the 11,365 occupied private dwellings in the Yukon in 2001, 7,155 (63.0%) were owned, 3,545 (31.2%) were rented and 665 (5.8%) were band housing.


Structure

Single detached houses represented 68.8% of occupied private dwellings in the Yukon in 2002. Apartments in buildings of fewer than 5 stories represented 10.8% of dwellings.

Condition

In 2001, 56.7% of dwellings in the Yukon required only regular maintenance, 29.4% required minor repairs and 13.9% required major repairs.



A release on May 13, 2003 will provide information on religion, shelter costs, income and social and economic characteristics of individuals, families and households.
