

# Remember, You Need a Valid Permit to Light an Open Fire

If you plan to burn grass, brush or debris between April 1 and September 30, you are required to obtain a Burning Permit. Burning Permits are required for all **PUBLIC** and **PRIVATE** lands (subject to municipal bylaws).

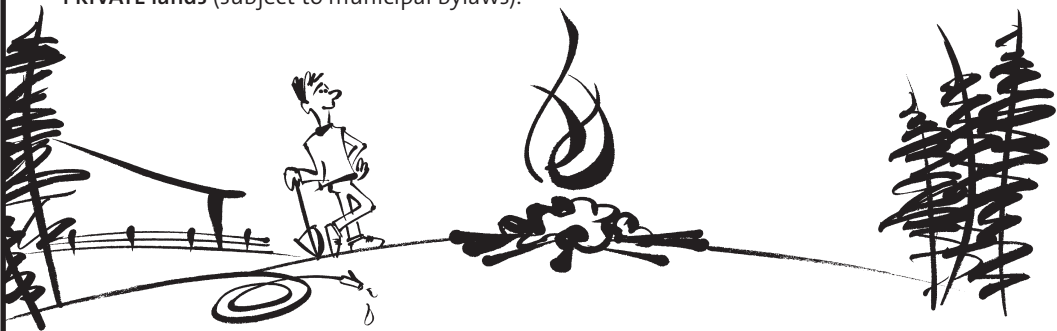
