## Remember, You Need a Valid Permit to Light an Open Fire

If you plan to burn grass, brush or debris between April 1 and September 30, you are required to obtain a Burning Permit. Burning Permits are required for all PUBLIC and PRIVATE lands (subject to municipal bylaws) Burning Permits are Free
