Purpose and Principles

The Department of Education supports:

- 1. Educational programs that promote physical wellness through outdoor activities.
- 2. School and student preparedness to protect against injury.
- 3. Student use of helmets in outdoor and winter activities as per the Canadian Medical Association's endorsement of helmet use.

Guidelines and Procedures

- 1. All Yukon public school students are required to wear helmets when engaging in the following school sponsored activities:
 - i. alpine skiing;
 - ii. snowboarding;
- iii. ice hockey;
- iv. skateboarding;
- v. inline skating;
- vi. speed skating;

vii. roller blading;

viii. ice skating

ix. mountain biking;

x. road biking.

- 2. Any agreement with a commercial service provider shall include a requirement to provide helmets for these activities.
- 3. Administrators, at their discretion, may require that helmets be worn for any other school activity.
